Law Department has an autonomous (open-shelf) library of about 60,000 monographs and more than 900 journal issues; users have 120 study stations, 9 computer stations (one of which is reserved for students with disabilities) and a fast digitization workstation.

The departmental library also consists of:

- **"Fondo Antichi"** room with about 2,500 editions of antiquarian value: included are the opera omnia of jurists such as Bartolo di Sassoferato, Cuiacio, Paolo de Castro, Bartolomeo Cipolla and other illustrious glossators and commentators, as well as exponents of the mos Italicus, mos Gallicus, usus modernus pandectarum and also works by 19th and early 20th century Pandectrists;

- **A Room of Roman Law and History of Romanist Studies**, which has Professor Archi's library, consisting of nearly 8,000 volumes and about 20 current journals subscriptions;

- **A 'Centro Studi sul Rischio'** room with about 6,000 volumes of Sociology and Philosophy of Law.

All other University libraries are also available to students and scholars.
